

**PTO Executive Committee**  
**MEETING MINUTES**  
**October 12, 2021 at 1:00pm**

Shannon Holt called the meeting to order at 1:03pm.

Shannon called for a motion to approve the minutes from the September 2021 PTO Executive Committee Meeting. Ann Bailey motioned to approve. Meredith Waldrop seconded the motion.

Christy Christian presented her Part B Request and thanked the PTO for their continued financial support to Crestline. She is so grateful for all that the parents do for Crestline. The changes that she made this year are as follows: Homeroom teachers added \$200 for an additional teacher. Technology added \$25,000 to add 13 more ViewSonic Panels for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grades. Kindergarten furniture is \$25,000. Auditorium additions were \$5,000 for stairs and speakers. Christy's Part B request totals were \$105,500.

Stacy Townsend presented the Treasurer's report. The current ServisFirst balance is \$235,514.67.

Shannon Holt presented the Final Fundraising report. The Cougar Contributor amount raised is \$178,000, the Grand Circle amount is \$69,350 and the business amount is \$9,850. The PTO budgeted for \$190,000 and the total received was \$258,000.

Shannon Holt called for a motion to approve Christy's Part B Request. Meredith Waldrop made the motion to approve and Karon Staples seconded it.

Shannon Holt presented Committee Updates:

- Fall Festival- As of October 12<sup>th</sup>, 94 wristbands had been purchased. Thursday, October 21<sup>st</sup>, they will distribute the wristbands. They will sell before Fall Festival and the day of the event. Room moms will send out sign ups to get volunteers to help with each booth.
- Veteran's Day Parade- It will be like last year. They will send an email about signing your veteran up to be a part of the event. The parade will start at MB Baptist and drive past Crestline while students and faculty cheer them on. The parade will take place on Wednesday, November 12<sup>th</sup> at 9:45am. There will not be a program this year.

Shannon Holt presented Other Business:

- Cougar Creed Contest- Crestline wants to have a Cougar Strong Creed that the students recite every day. It will be a rap or cheer that explains what Cougar Strong means. Students can submit example creeds through Flip Grid.
