MEETING MINUTES
May 11th, 2021 at 1:30 p.m. (hybrid)

Shannon went over the Christy's Part A Request. The number was lower than last year. She added in \$4,000 for Camp Alpine since it was \$0 for this past year. She added \$500 to the Preschool because it is expanding rapidly. She added \$500 to Language Arts and Math Resources, and then she took away \$2,000 for First Lego League Materials/Kits because they had bought the kits last year. Meredith Waldrop motioned to approve the Part A Request. Connor Cranford seconded the motion.

Shannon gave an update on the Cougar Contributors Campaign. 27 families have contributed so far, totaling \$26,150. Leslie Corts and Rebecca Wise will present letters to businesses in the community who want to give to Crestline.

Shannon went over Policies and Procedures:

-Social Media Policy- It will be the same as last year. Jessica Donald will be handling Facebook and Instagram. In July new people will be admitted into the Crestline Facebook and Instagram accounts, as well as, graduating families will be removed from the accounts.

-The Reimbursement From will stay the same.

-The Policy and Procedures will be updated over the summer.

Shannon went over the PTO Council Meeting that took place on May 4th. She said that Dickey Barlow hopes to not mask next year. They have some pilot plans in place for the summer to see how non-masking goes in different camps that will be taking place in the schools. He went over construction at all of the schools.

Shannon sent out the Willingness to Serve Survey and 102 people have responded. Shannon plans to send it out again sometime in July to reach more people.
